

## Crossroads to Jericho

Finished block: 8-1/2"  
Pieced block: 9-1/4"

### MATERIALS

One 2-1/2" x 12 1/2" strip of muslin (provided)  
Four 5 1/4" jewel tone-on-tone small print squares

### CUTTING

#### Muslin

1. Cut five 2 1/2" squares

#### Each jewel square

1. Cut each square in half diagonally
2. Set aside one triangle
3. From the other triangle cut a 2 1/2" square

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

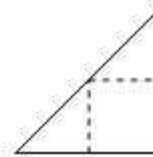
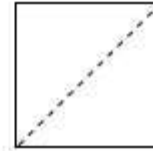
Use 1/4" seam throughout.

#### Nine Patch

1. Use muslin squares for the four corners and center
2. Press individual strips towards jewel squares
3. Press joining seams to the center

#### Corners

1. Find the middle of each jewel square and triangle of the same fabric
2. Match and sew the corner triangle to the nine-patch (Note: Extra fabric has been included in the triangle to allow for squaring the block)
3. Press the seam to the jewel corner
4. Square the block to 9 1/4"
