

Block of the Month ~ May / June 2011

Tulip


- 1) Dark color on color
 - A. Cut one 2" square
- 2) White on White
 - B. Cut one 3.5" square
 - C. Cut one 3 7/8" square
 - D. Cut one 2" square
 - E. Cut one 2" x 3.5" rectangle
- 3) Light or pastel contrasting color to dark color
 - F. Cut one 3 7/8" square
 - G. Cut one 3.5" x 6.5" rectangle

Corner Unit

Sew the 2" square (A) and (D) squares together first.



Then sew the 2" x 3.5" rectangle (E) to the long edge of the A/D pieces




Construct Tulip Block

Triangle square Unit

Take the 3 7/8" squares (C and F) and cut each on the diagonal.

You will need only one block. Sew right sides together and press open, forming a block as follows:




Diagonal Seam Unit

Take the 3.5" square (B) and set on top at one end of the 3.5" x 6.5" rectangle (G), right sides together.

Stitch across (B) diagonally from corner to corner.


Trim 1/4" beyond the seam and press open.



Final Construction

Layout all the three units and sew together as shown below.

Each completed block should measure 6.5" x 6.5".
