




# Block of the Month ~ May 2013

## MAY FLOWERS FOR THE QUILTER

### CUTTING:


- 1- Floral fabric
  - 8 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
  - 4 squares 4 7/8" x 4 7/8"



- 2- Color on color or solid fabric
  - 8 squares 4 7/8" x 4 7/8"
  - 8 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

### MAKING THE BLOCK:

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each 2 1/2" square. Place a 2 1/2" square on top of a fat quarter 4 1/2" square. With right sides together and edges matched, stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowances to 1/4"; press. Make eight units.





Make 8.

2. Sew a fat-eighth and a fat-quarter triangle together. Make eight half-square-triangle units.



Make 8.

3. Sew two units from step 1 and two units from step 2 together as shown to make a spool unit. Make four units. Sew the units together as shown.
