SCRAP BUSTER BLOCK

Unfinished size: $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$



1. Cut a piece of muslin $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$.
2. Draw a line from corner to corner diagonally.
3. Place two strips of fabric right sides together with the edges meeting the line you have drawn on the muslin
4. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ from the edge.
5. Flip the top piece and press.
6. Place another strip of fabric on the raw edges of both the first fabrics.
7. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ from each edge and flip and press.
8. Continue until the $9\frac{1}{2}''$ square is filled.

There are no color or strip width requirements. Use your strip scraps.
