
DOUBLE NINE PATCH

Materials: 2 Fat quarters. One dark color which is best if plain or small print One light color (white or cream)


- 1.From color scrap cut 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip width of fabric for "B" Squares Then cut 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (4 of them) from that strip
- 2. From very light color cut 5" strip width of fabric for "A" rectangles. Then cut $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (4 of them) from that strip ($3 \frac{1}{2} \times 3$)

Set aside those pieces.

- 3. Cut 2" strip of color scrap, (2" by 16") Then cut 16" into two 8" strips
- 4. Cut 2' X 24" strip of light. Then cut light strip into 3 strips to make three 2"X 8" strips.
- 6. Sew 2 X 8" strips together Color, light, color until you have three strips



7. Then sew light strip. color strip, light strip to create center 9 patch for block.




Strip Set #2 Diagram






8. Continue construction of nine patch block with small 9 patch in center of block. Finished block should measure $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $10 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
