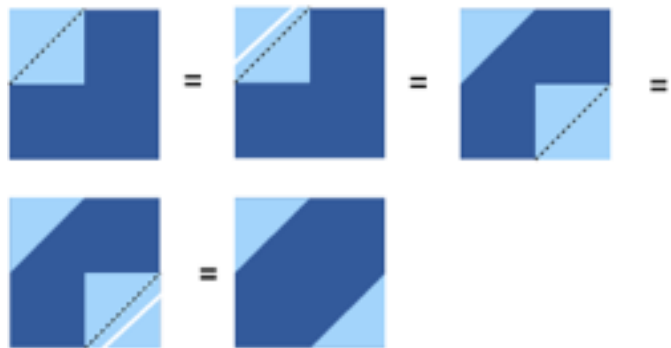
Cutting Instructions:

Fabric:	Size & Shape:	# to Cut:
A (Purple)	4-1/2" Square	3
A (Purple)	2-1/2" Square	6
A (Purple)	2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Rectangle	4
B (White)	2-1/2" Square	4
B (White)	2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Rectangle	4
B (White)	4-1/2" Square	2

Sewing Instructions:

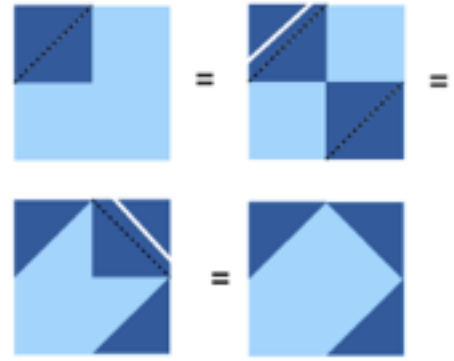
Step 1: Using a pencil and a ruler, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all Color A (Purple) 2-1/2" squares, and all Color B (White) 2-1/2" squares.

Step 2: Place a Color B (White) 2-1/2" square in the upper left corner of a Color A (Purple) 4-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew along the diagonal line that you drew in Step 1. Trim away the fabric 1/4" above the seam and press the seam allowance toward the Color B (White) fabric. Trim points. Repeat in the lower right corner, as shown below. Make 2. (This unit should measure 4-1/2" square.)



Sew, trim, and press. Make 2.

Step 3: Place a Color A (Purple) 2-1/2" square in the upper left corner of a Color B (White) 4-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew along the diagonal line that you drew in Step 1. Trim away the fabric 1/4" above the seam and press the seam allowance toward the Color A (Purple) fabric. Trim points. Repeat in two more corners, as shown below. Make 2. (This unit should measure 4-1/2" square.)



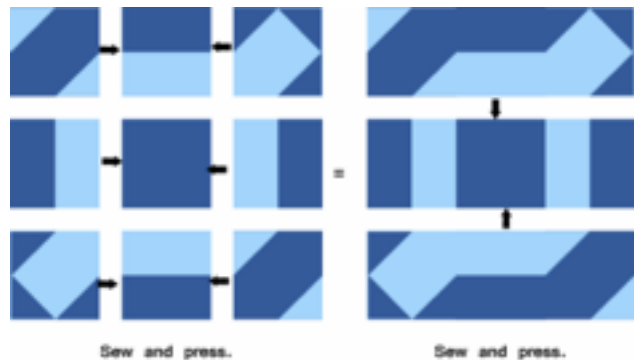
Sew, trim, and press. Make 2.

Step 4: Sew a Color A (Purple) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to a Color B (White) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle, as shown below. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Make 4. (This unit should measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2")



Sew and press. Make 4

Step 5: Arrange the Step 2 units, the Step 3 units, the Step 4 units, and the Color A (Purple) 4-1/2" square as shown below. Sew into rows and press the seam allowances toward the Step 4 units. Next, sew the rows together to finish the block. Press the seam allowances toward the center row.

Here is a sample quilt layout for the Chain Link quilt block:
