## Supplies

2 - 10" squares cut into 4's

(or 4 - 5" squares of white

4 - 5" squares of red or other bright pins

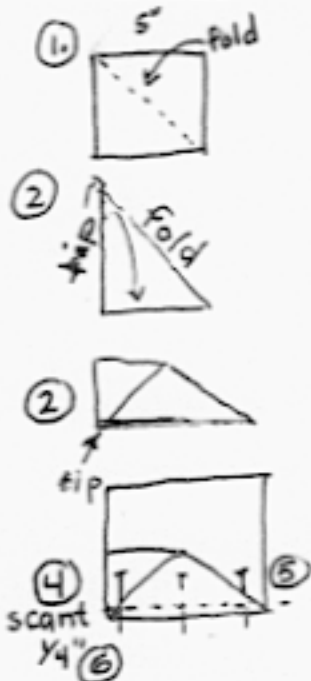
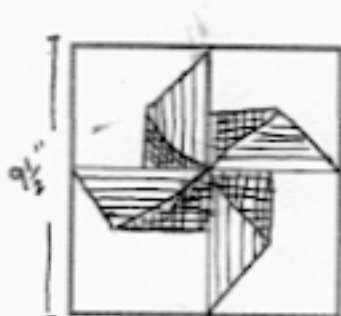

1. Take each pinwheel square and fold diagonally.
2. Take one corner (with 2 raw edges) and fold to spine of triangle.
3. Lightly iron or finger press.
4. Layout background squares.
5. Pin each folded pinwheel piece to background square so the pinwheel flow clockwise.
6. Sew pinwheel piece to background squares with 1/8" to a scant 1/4"
7. Lay out sewn piece
8. Sew top 2 squares together with 1/4" seams
9. Sew bottom 2 squares with 1/4" seams
10. Sew 2 halves together with seam allowances flipped oppositely to make a flatter seam
11. Press seams open,
12. Fluff pinwheels to show their 3 dimensions.
