

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Colorful Gems

The easiest block you'll ever make, allowing you to spend your time on creating creative color combos! Just FOLD and SEW!

Lay the 5" block exactly in the middle of the 10" block. (2 1/2" around all the sides of the 5" block)



Fold the left and




Fold the left and right edges to meet in the middle, (2 1/2" inches) leaving the 5" square inside.







One 5" square piece of fabric or charm square
iron
sewing machine
