## Piece By Piece Quilters Block of the Month for April, 2019

Churn Dash - 9 1/2 inch (9 inch finished size)
Use the colors of Spring wild flowers - yellow and purple, and our beautiful green hills.


## Materials

Center square: a medium-light tone blender or solid. One $31 / 2$ " square.
Main color: a medium-dark tone floral or print. Two 4" squares and one strip 14 " $\times 2$ ". Background: Light spring color - cream or pale yellow, purple or green. Two 4" squares and one strip 14" $\times 2$ ".

## Instructions

1. Sides: Make four bar units
2. Sew together the two 14 " main color and background strips and press.
3. Cut the strip set into four $31 / 2^{\prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
4. Corners: Make four Half Square Triangles
5. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of the two background color 4 " squares.
6. Put the background color squares face to face with the main color squares.
7. Sew $1 / 4$ " lines on each side of the drawn diagonal line and then cut on the diagonal line to form four half square triangle units. Trim the units to a perfect 3 $1 / 2$ " square.
8. Sew together the nine units as illustrated in the sample.
9. Your completed block should measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
