

Piece by Piece Quilters March 2020

1. Cut: background (white) 2-(5 inch squares, cut diagonally once)


4-(rectangles 2 1/4 inch x 7 inch)

2. Cut: Green(as many greens as you like) 4-(5 inch squares, cut diagonally once)

3. Sew: unit A: pair a green triangle with white triangle as shown, be sure background triangle is always on left and green is on right.



4. Sew: unit B: Align one end of 2 1/4 x 7" rectangle with straight edge of green triangle and sew right sides facing. Notice the end of triangle does not extend to length of strip. After rectangle has been sewn in place, align ruler with long edge of triangle and trim excess fabric from end of rectangle



5. Sew Block: Sew unit A to unit B along diagonal edge and press. Align the 45 degree angle on ruler on center seam line, square to 6 inches. This completes one quadrant of block. Make for quadrants for each block and sew together as shown.
