

# Scrappy Pumpkin

9½" x 9½" Unfinished—9" x 9" Finished

## Fabric Requirement:

Background—White on White

1—2½" x 3¾" rectangle

1—2" Square

4—2¼" Squares

1—2½" Square

Oranges—Six orange scraps

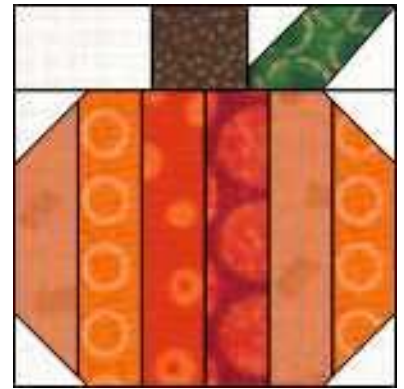
6—2" x 7½" Rectangles

Brown

1—2½" x 2¾" Rectangle

Green

1—2½" x 4"



Directions: Use a ¼" seam unless otherwise stated.

1. Sew the 6 orange rectangles together to create a 7 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the four background 2 ¼" squares. Sew each one to each corner of the orange fabric rectangle. Trim the seam to ¼".
2. Using the green rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 2" background square. Sew to the upper left corner of the green rectangle. Repeat with the 2 ½" background square and attach to the lower right side of the green rectangle. This unit is your leaf.
3. Sew the background 2 ½" x 3 ¾" to the left side of the brown and then sew this unit to the left of the leaf unit you made above.
4. Sew the stem/leaf unit to the top of the orange pumpkin unit. This block will measure 9 ½" square finished.
