## Jewelry Travel Bag

Needs two coordinating fat quarters.



Place your fat quarters right sides together and fold lengthwise. Using the template provided, place the template on the fold and cut out the 11" and 8" circles. You will have two of each size.

Take both circles and sew all the way around using  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.






Carefully pull the fabrics layers apart and cut a 1" "X" in the <u>center</u> of the inside fabric. Do this for both circles. Clip the curves. Turn and press. Top stitch  $\sim$  close to the outside edge of each circle.


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To form the casing, top stitch 5/8" from the edge all the way around the 11" circle. Top stitch again 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"from edge all the way around the 11" circle.






Center the 8" circle on the 11" circle with the holes (used for turning) facing together. Stitch along the drawn pocket lines; backstitch ends. Stitch all the way around the circle in the center.





On the outside of the 11" circle (inside the casing), carefully using sharp scissors (or a seam ripper) cut two slits in the casing through the top layer of fabric only (not the lining fabric) on opposite side of the circle. To avoid frying you can use fray check or whip stitch around the edges but it is not necessary.





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Cut two 30" lengths of 1/8" ribbon or cording. Thread one length of cording through one slit completely around the circle using a safety pin. Repeat with the other piece of cording on the opposite side. Tie each ribbon separately in a knot. Embellish with beads or buttons if you want.
