- 1....6 1/2 in printed fabric
- 1....6 1/2 in white fabric
- 1....2 in by 6 in strip


## PIECING:

- 1. PLACE FABRICS RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER.
- \* ON WRONG SIDE OF WHITE SOLID (6 1/2 in.) sq. DRAW DIAGONAL LINE, THEN SEW 1/4 in SEAM ON EACH SIDE OF MARKED LINE.
- \* CUT APART ON DIAGONAL LINE, PRESS OPEN
- \* TO MAKE SQUARES. TRIM PIECED SQUARES
- \* TO 6 IN SQUARE.
- 2. REFERRING TO DIAGRAM II, CUT PIECED SQUARE INTO 4 (1- 1/2IN) SEGMENTS
- 3. REFERRING TO DIAGRAM III, STITCH MATCHING PRINT 2in by 6in AND SEGMENTS TOGETHER AS SHOWN





